

Compulsory Safety Rules

- ALL EMPLOYEES MUST OBSERVE THE SAFETY AND RISK PREVENTION INSTRUCTIONS
- SAFETY HELMET, HI-VIZ JACKET AND SAFETY SHOES MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES DURING THE OPERATIONS AND WHEN WALKING THROUGH THE TERMINAL
- DO NOT WALK BETWEEN THE CONTAINER ROWS
- NO SMOKING
- USE TOILETS WHEN NECESSARY
- DO NOT LEAVE RUBBISH OR ANY WASTE IN THE TERMINAL. PLEASE USE THE REFUSE BINS
- IF YOU HEAR AN EVACUATION ALARM PROCEED TO THE CLOSEST MEETING POINT
- DO NOT DRINK ALCOHOL IN THE TERMINAL
- DO NOT STAND UNDER SUSPENDED CONTAINERS, UNLESS IT IS NECESSARY FOR LOADING/ UNLOADING
- DO NOT WALK CLOSE TO THE WATER'S EDGE
- IF YOU NEED TO EXIT THE TERMINAL, PLEASE DO SO FOLLOWING THE FOOT PATH TOWARDS THE TURNSTILE. ENTRY AND EXISTS INSTRUCTIONS ARE DISPLAY ON

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING/LEAVING THE TERMINAL

- 1) To exit the Terminal, please follow the Pedestrian path between bollards 13 and 14 parallel to the truck access lane. You'll reach the exit turnstile close to the office building
- 2) Once there, please press the intercom and identify yourself (vessel name and lastname)
- 3) Security will check your credentials and let you through if you're on the vessel crew list
- 4) Once you leave the premises through the car entrance, you'll see a green metal gate across the road. From there, you can access the main road with bus-stops towards both Santa Cruz (the city) and San Andres (Teresitas beach)



IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

In case of evacuation of the terminal

- 1) The evacuation will begin as soon as the acoustic alarm goes off
- 2) The main official/Captain will contact TCT personnel immediately
- 3) The emergency chief or Operations manager Will inform each foreman and the stevedors by radio
- 4) The foreman will be responsible for informing the rest of his gang that they need to stop operations and go to the closest Meeting Point using the evacuation routes (pedestrian crossings)
- 5) The vessel crew will go to the meeting points safely and calmly and follow the instructions given by TCT personnel
- 6) Once in the meeting point, each foreman and stevedor Will verify that all the people in their gangs are there. They'll inform the Emergency Chief or Operations Manager

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

- IF YOU DETECT AN INCIDENT, PLEASE INFORM SECURITY (+34 606 220 061) OR TCT CONTROL CENTER (+34 922 990 430)
- PROVIDE AS MUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE ON:
 - Location of the incident
 - Type of incident (spill, fire, etc)
 - People affected. Type of substance involved
 - Damages
 - Actions already taken
- KEEP CALM AND ACT, IF NECESSARY, WITH THE AVAILABLE MEANS
- DO NOT TAKE ANY RISKS
- FOLLOW INDICATIONS BY TCT PERSONNEL
